

TERMS & CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS:

A completed application and a \$500 deposit are required to reserve a space.

A second payment of \$500 is due 120 days prior to departure. Full payment must be received 60 days prior to departure.

CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellation fees are computed, as of the date we receive your written cancellation notice, as follows:

CANCELLATION FEES:

- More than 90 days before departure - \$200
plus \$100 for Inca Trail permit (if purchased)
- 89 to 61 days before departure - \$300
plus \$100 for Inca Trail permit (if purchased)
- 60 to 31 days before departure - 50% of land cost
plus \$100 for Inca Trail permit (if purchased)
- 30 days or less to departure 100% of selling price

Deposit and cancellation fees for extensions

A nonrefundable \$75 per person deposit is required to reserve an extension. The deposit is fully refundable if we cannot secure your extension. Full payment of extension is due with the final payment of the trip.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

We highly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/interruption insurance to protect your travel investment.

You will receive an e-mail with information for travel insurance to cover trip cancellation, interruption, baggage loss and delay, emergency medical evacuation insurance and emergency medical expense insurance. This coverage generally reimburses the non-refundable air and land costs should you have to cancel due to a medical emergency or illness involving yourself, a family member as well as expenses of a medical evacuation.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

A passport valid beyond your date of return is required. Perú, Chile, Argentina and Ecuador do not require previously issued visas from citizens of the United States. Those with passports from other countries call us or call the appropriate consular office.

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION:

Upon registration you will receive a confirmation letter and a detailed package with recommended clothing and equipment list, insurance and other information needed to prepare for the trip.

MEDICAL:

All participants must be in general good health. Trip members will receive a medical report to be filled out and returned to us.

VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate on the trip designated on this application and that I have carefully read and understand the description, terms, conditions and recommendations of the trip in the enclosed itinerary. I am participating in this trip with knowledge of the hazards involved. I am aware that adventure travel to remote areas like the ones visited in this trip, involves risks and dangers including but not limited to: the hazards of traveling in mountainous terrain, high altitudes, travel by raft, boat, plane, automobile, horseback or by other means of conveyance, or on foot; the forces of nature; civil unrest; terrorism; accidents or illness without access to means of evacuation or the availability of medical supplies; the negligence (but not willful or fraudulent) on the part of Andes Adventures, Devy Reinstein or others; or factors known or unknown. I am also aware that medical services or facilities may not be readily available or accessible during some of the time that I am participating in the trip. I hereby accept and assume full responsibility for any and all risk of illness, injury or death.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in this trip, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators; waive and release any and all claims that I may have against any and all persons affiliated with this event including but not limited to, event promoters and sponsors, Andes Adventures, Devy Reinstein, agents, employees or associates, arising out of, or in any way connected with my participation in the trip.

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RESPONSIBILITY

Andes Adventures reserves the right to increase the trip price in the event of costs increases due to changes in air fares, currency fluctuations or park entrance fee increases.

Andes Adventures reserves the right to cancel any trip that does not reach a minimum level of participants to make it economically feasible for us to operate. We will inform you at least 45 days before departure. The refund for all monies received shall be the limit of our liability. Andes Adventures is not responsible for any expenses incurred in preparing for a cancelled trip.
